To Grade 12 Students submitting APPLICATIONS for DISTRICT SCHOLARSHIPS

- The deadline is **April 16th**. If you wish to apply for a District Award (hereinafter referred to as District Scholarship), submit the application to your school's Awards Co-ordinator by the deadline. To be a recipient, you must be an applicant. Aim for **timeliness**, **thoroughness**, **and legibility** when completing your application.
- If you need to **revise** something after the deadline, contact your Awards Co-ordinator.

- The <u>intent</u> of the District Scholarships is to acknowledge <u>excellence in non-academic fields</u> and to assist with tuition for furthering students' post-secondary education. The student does not have to be pursuing post-secondary education in the non-academic field although <u>priority</u> may be given to students who are pursuing one of those areas.

- The <u>application</u> for the District Scholarship collects data pertaining to your personal information, areas of achievement and of post-secondary education or career, achievement; preparation, and support from one or more references. You must supply your Personal Education Number and address as well as a transcript of grade 10, 11, and 12 courses. References are to be placed in sealed envelopes by the individuals providing them to you (or referees may choose to submit their input directly to the school's Awards Co-ordinator).
- Page 4 of the application—the <u>Specialist Teacher Reference</u>—is mandatory. <u>The teacher must be on the staff of your current school</u>.
 - Page 5—the <u>Community Member Reference</u>—is optional <u>if the teacher providing the Page 4</u> reference has worked with you in the area of excellent achievement you identified on Page 2, or in an area related to your career goal.
- 7 Selection will be based on <u>evaluation in the chosen area of achievement and other factors</u> (which may include attendance, punctuality, work habits, co-operation).
- If you are an intended recipient of a District Scholarship, you must complete your **graduation requirements** (Dogwood 2018 Graduation Program or Adult Graduation Program) by August 31.

 After that date, your **selection** will be confirmed with the school, the Board, and the Ministry.

 Subsequently, the Ministry will provide you with a \$1,250 voucher that can be used toward post-secondary education tuition. Vouchers are scheduled to be mailed by November. There is a five-year claim period.
