## How TO REDEEM

FIND OUT if you've been awarded a scholarship  
Vouchers mailed to students in late fall after graduation, and scholarship notices posted on [www.studenttranscripts.gov.bc.ca](http://www.studenttranscripts.gov.bc.ca)

ATTEND designated post-secondary institution or approved program provider

SUBMIT your voucher to the Ministry for reimbursement of tuition paid

USE before it expires

WAIT for your cheque to arrive, in the mail, in about 8 weeks
